

# Packing Checklist

## Prohibited items

- Space heaters
- Candles & Incense
- Water pipes, bongs, and hookahs
- Hot Plate Burners
- Halogen Lamps
- Dishwasher
- Washer & Dryer

## Items You Will Need

### Residence Hall Room & Bath Items

Items you may want to bring for your room and bathroom:

- Bedsheets (twin XL-size or full XL-size, depending on room type)
- Comforters, quilts, blankets
- Mattress pads
- Pillows and pillowcases
- Ear plugs or white noise machine if you're a sensitive sleeper
- Paper towels
- Toilet paper (excluding suites)
- Tissues
- Towels (including hand and bath towels, washcloths)
- Extra storage bins
- Shower shoes (like flip flops) for residents using community showers
- Basket or shower caddy to carry bathroom supplies for residents in single units or shared apartments/suites
- Bathroom cleaning supplies

### Clothing and Laundry Supplies

**Please know that laundry costs \$1.50 per load.**

Items you may want to bring for clothing and laundry:

- Clothing/accessories for cold weather such as: sweaters, heavy coats, scarves, gloves, snow boots, earmuffs, etc.
- Clothing/accessories for warmer weather such as: light clothing, sandals, sunglasses, walking shoes, hats, sunscreen, etc.
- Iron or steamer and ironing board
- Laundry basket or bag
- Laundry detergent
- Stain remover stick
- Dryer sheets
- Bleach and fabric softener
- Quarters or credit/debit card for laundromats

### Personal Care Products

Items you may want to bring for health and grooming purposes:

- Bath soap or shower gels
- Shampoos and conditioners
- Deodorant
- Comb or brush
- Hairdryer, curling iron, etc.
- Toothbrush, toothpaste, mouthwash, floss, etc.
- Shaving kit
- Lotions and cosmetics
- Cotton swabs
