

TECHNOLOGY ENHANCED PHYSICAL ACTIVITY PROGRAMS FOR BRONX ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS

Join us for our next talk with the CEO and Founder of Equity Design, Maurelhena Walles. Equity Design is a social enterprise that brings equity to disadvantaged populations in under-served communities through nontraditional and sustainable programming that will help increase their life expectancy while creating a long-lasting and healthy connection to physical activity.

Walles will discuss Equity Design's approach to developing individualized activity plans for elementary school students. In direct response to the physical health needs of Bronx elementary school students, Maurelhena and her team used an equity lens to (1) design a physical activity programs that addresses the lack of physical activity engagement while also (2) establishing a fitness tracking database that measures the correlation between a student's academic performance, experience and engagement to physical activity.
