## **DFI Announces Transmediation Fellowships**

This year's Transmediation Fellows are Dr. Beth Rubin (Dept. of Arts and Humanities) and Dr. Rachel Talbert (Dept. of Curriculum and Teaching).

Dr. Rubin's transmediation project grows out of her ongoing <u>Civically</u> <u>Engaged Districts Project</u>, a community-engaged research practice partnership dedicated to supporting schools and districts to become more nurturing spaces for youth civic development. Dr. Rubin will collaborate with the Digital Futures Institute to produce a series of video interviews that will allow students, teachers, and school leaders to hear from peers and others who have undertaken civic action research about their experiences.

Dr. Talbert will collaborate with the Digital Futures Institute to produce videos and site-based media that extend her ongoing collaboration with the Lenape Center in New York City, in the development of curricular materials that raise awareness for K12 students about Lenape history—as well as public-facing work.
