Ally is an integrated tool in Canvas that helps instructors enhance accessibility of digital content in their

courses. Ally instantly checks your Canvas course files for common accessibility issues using a scoring system. Ally then provides guidance and tips for improvements that will drastically increase the accessibility of your

course content and creates alternative formats for your files, such as audio files, screen readable PDFs, etc. Instructors can improve file accessibility with Ally's step-by-step instructions.
